NM WCA EDI Claims Release 3.1 Information Announcement

**NM WCA EDI Claims Release 3.1,
Information Session Recording and Presentation Slides are Now Available and
Reminder Trading Partner (Direct Reporters) and EDI Vendor Testing will begin April 11, 2025.**

New Mexico, in conjunction with their EDI Claims Vendor, Verisk, have prepared the EDI Claims Release 3.1 Information Session Presentation recording and PDF slides which can be found on the Training Information page of the NMWCA EDI Claims website: <https://nmwcaedi.info/training>.

This training was prepared to assist Trading Partners in understanding the transition from R1 to R3.1 and interpreting the new requirements for the state of New Mexico.

The testing period for NMWCA Trading Partners (Direct SFTP) and EDI Vendors will **begin on April 11, 2025**. EDI Vendors and Trading Partners submitting claims data directly are required to complete the Test Plan. The NMWCA Test Plan is available at <https://nmwcaedi.info/impl-info>.

Any Direct SFTP trading partner or EDI Vendor who has not completed and passed the FROI/SROI testing will not be advanced to production.

Exceptions: No testing is required for the Jurisdiction Web Entry filers using wcPrism. In some cases, if a Trading Partner is using an EDI Vendor, the EDI Vendor will coordinate and/or perform the testing on behalf of the Trading Partner.

Please note the following important information regarding the incoming test files:

- Must contain proper information consistent with the approved method on the TPP
- The Test/Production Indicator (DN0104) located in position 82 of the Header Record should be set to 'T' for all testing

Testing concludes October 31, 2025, and the implementation date for EDI Claims Release 3.1 is November 7, 2025.

As a reminder, if you have not completed a new trading partner profile registration for the transition from IAIABC EDI Claims Release 1.0 to Release 3.1, please have this completed.
